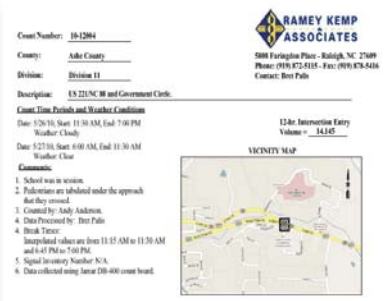


# NCDOT On-Call Traffic Data Collection

RKA is currently providing on-call data collection for the NCDOT TESSB at various intersections and locations across the state. Data collection includes pedestrian counts, turning movement vehicle counts, classification counts, and railroad volume/classifications counts. Pedestrian counts are collected at intersections along the approach that the pedestrian crosses. The project requires coordination with NCDOT personnel and field data collectors. Data collection efforts are required on short time schedules.

From May of 2010 to February of 2011 Ramey Kemp & Associates will have collected Average Daily Traffic Data at 210 railroad crossings spanning across central and eastern North Carolina for NCDOT. Each submittal consists of 48 hours of traffic data collected at thirty crossings sites which are submitted to NCDOT within thirty days.

RKA also held a data collection contract with the NCDOT from 2001 to 2006. During these two contracts we completed over 550 counts.
